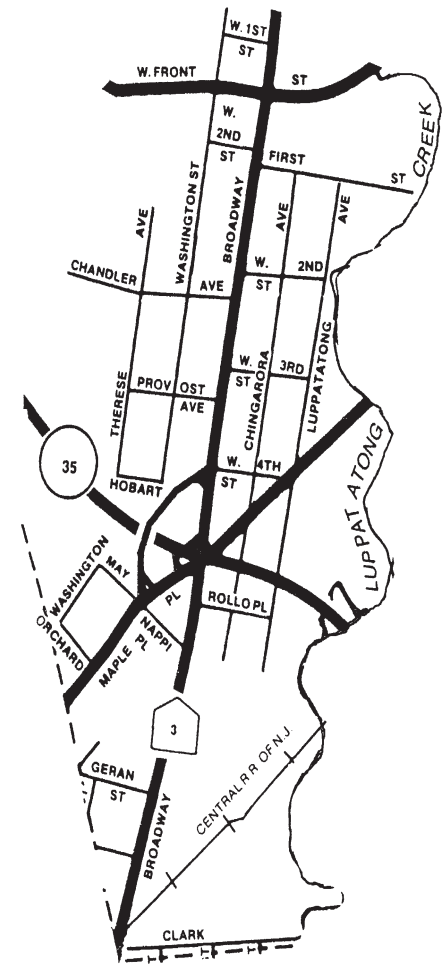


DISTRICT 1

Leaf Pickup & Branch Pickup Schedule

Leaves and branches Apr 25, May 23
Branches Only Aug 22, Sep 26
Leaves and branches Oct 24, Nov 7, 28
Dec 12

LEAVES – Leaves must be placed in biodegradable paper bags at curbside not before 6 p.m. on the day before the dates specific to your district above. Residents are entitled to 25 bags per year per lot of properties owned. Bags must be picked up at the Recycling Center. You may use additional self-purchased bags, however, they must be paper and marked “biodegradable.” Do not mix anything in with leaves. Mulching or composting is a good option. **Do not place loose leaves or grass into curbs at any time.**

BRANCHES – Must be no longer than 6 feet and no more than 4 inches in diameter. Branches must be tied in bundles. Do not block sidewalks or place branches in streets.

Your weekly curbside collection of non-recyclable solid waste is MONDAY.

Place all solid waste curbside on scheduled day; exceptions are New Year's Day, Christmas Day and Thanksgiving Day; they will be picked up the following day.

Welcome To Recycling In Keyport

All information to successfully recycle in The Borough of Keyport is contained within this pamphlet. When at an event use the proper container for trash and recycling items.

Effective January 1, 2011, you may no longer place TV's and other electronic items out with your regular trash. They are now designated bulk items by a new State of New Jersey law. Check E-scrap for types of material and how it should be disposed.

A new ordinance requiring a \$30.00 non-refundable dumpster fee for construction and demolition materials has been enacted this year.

The Recycling Center will be open every Saturday from 9am to noon for your convenience. A menu of items that may be dropped at this site is available and posted at the Center.
