**Your weekly curbside collection of non-recyclable solid waste is FRIDAY.**

NOTE: Place all solid waste curbside on scheduled day; exceptions are New Year's Day, Christmas Day and Thanksgiving Day; they will be picked up the following day.

### Welcome To Recycling In Keyport

This pamphlet contains all necessary information to successfully recycle in the Borough of Keyport. *One major item removed from the recycling list is dry cell batteries, sizes AAA, AA, A, C, D and 9 volt. They are to be discarded with your general trash. Another item of concern to recycling is the compact fluorescent lamp (CFL). This item can be recycled, unbroken, at The Home Depot.*

If you miss your regularly scheduled pick-up, the Recycling Center, located on Florence Avenue and Highway 36, is open every Saturday from 9am to 12noon. A menu of items that can be dropped at this site is available for your information.

A paper shredding event will be scheduled in the Borough. Residents will be informed when this event will be scheduled by the County. Each resident will be permitted one hundred pounds of paper.

Continue to recycle in the Borough, you are making a difference.

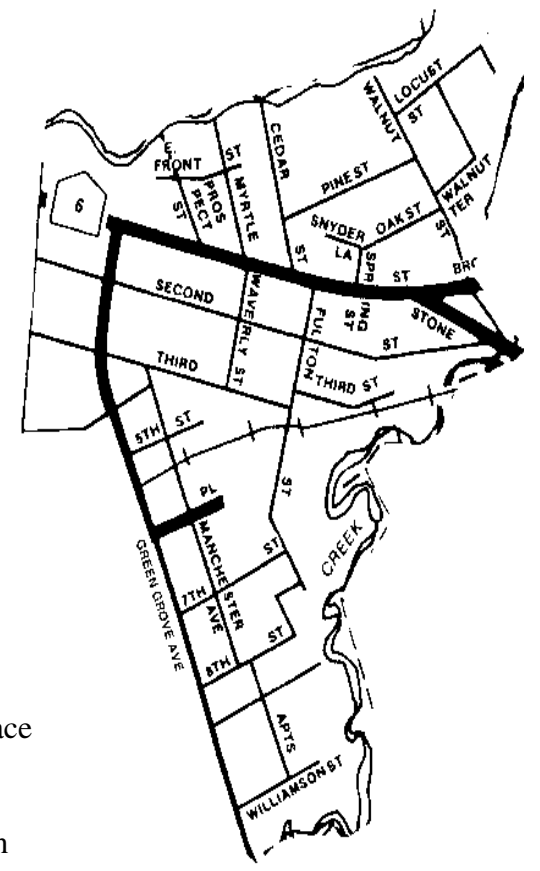

## Leaf Pickup & Branch Pickup Schedule

Leaves and branches	Apr 23, May 21
Branches only	Aug 27, Oct 1
Leaves and branches	Oct 29, Nov 12, Dec 3, 17

**LEAVES** – Leaves must be placed in biodegradable paper bags at curbside not before 6 p.m. on the day before the dates specific to your district above. Residents are entitled to 25 bags per year per lot of properties owned. Bags must be picked up at the Recycling Center. You may use additional self-purchased bags, however, they must be paper and marked “biodegradable.” Do not mix anything in with leaves. Mulching or composting is a good option. Do not place loose leaves or grass into curbs.

**BRANCHES** – Must be no longer than 6 feet and no more than 4 inches in diameter. Branches must be tied in bundles. Do not block sidewalks or place branches in streets.
