The Recycling Center is open from 9 a.m. to noon on Saturdays except Holidays. It is located at Florence Avenue and Highway 36.

Business and Commercial Information - All commercial entities are required to recycle everything listed. In addition, your company may generate waste material that is mandated recyclable, however, it may not be listed herein, such as food waste. Contact the Department of Health for local ordinances governing commercial properties. Your private hauler must provide weight slips annually to the Recycling Office for all your recyclables handled.

Landlords - Unwanted dwelling contents that exceed quantity and categories collected in this program must be removed at your own expense. Excess items left on the curb may result in summonses.

Lawn Care Companies and Homeowners - Do not blow vegetation into road; summonses may result. Debris clogs storm sewers causing flooding and pollutes our waterways.
