Tax & Water/Sewer Billing Information

Hours of Operation: Monday – Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM

Quarterly Tax Payments:

- Due on **February 1, May 1, August 1, and November 1.**
- A **10-day grace period** applies. On the **11th day, interest is accrued** back to the 1st of the month, per state law.
- Tax bills are mailed **annually in July/August**. If you do not receive a bill, you are still responsible for payment (NJSA54:4-64).
- If annual bills are mailed late, the due date remains **August 1**. However, under NJSA 54:4-66.3d, a **resolution is passed to delay interest accrual for 25 days**. If payment is made past this date, interest is charged retroactively to August 1.

Account Updates: Please submit any changes in writing (e.g., new mailing address, mortgage company changes). Notices can be faxed to **732-739-4701**.

Water & Sewer Payments:

- Billed **quarterly** with due dates on **January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1.**
- A **10-day grace period** applies. Interest is accrued from the **1st of the month** per NJ State Statute.
- Bills are mailed around the **15th of the previous month.**

Payment Extensions for Weekends & Holidays:

- If a collection day falls on a **Saturday or Sunday**, payments are accepted until the following **Monday without interest.**
- If the last day to pay is a **holiday**, the next business day is the deadline.

Payment Options:

- **Drop-Box:** Located in the **vestibule of 70 West Front Street** (No cash payments accepted). Payments are posted on the **pickup date (Monday-Friday, 9 AM-10 AM)**. Payments dropped after 10 AM are posted on the next business day.
- **Online Payments:** Visit www.keyportonline.com. Click on **Tax and Water Sewer Payments**, read notices, and proceed.
- **E-Check:** \$1.95 per transaction
- **Credit/Debit Card:** 2.95% of the transaction amount
- *Convenience fees are retained by the service provider and not by the Borough of Keyport.*

Moving?

- Schedule a **final meter reading** to receive a **final bill** before moving.

Meter Maintenance:

- Residents are responsible for meter upkeep, especially **during winter.**

ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

Welcome aboard to two new Commissioners, Lennie Walker and Kathleen Bell de Los Reyes!

In April 2024, seniors from Kean University, under Project Manager Matthew Wolfe and Dr. Daniela Shebitz, Chair and Professor of Environmental and Sustainable Sciences, partnered with the Keyport Environmental Commission to present on the Upper Dune/Living Shoreline Project at Cedar Street Park. The presentation covered a variety of topics, including the identification of invasive plant species, the development of a restoration plan, research into permits, and the methodology for storm-damage wave mitigation along the shoreline. BOARD OF HEALTH

As per State Statute, dogs are required to be licensed in the Borough of Keyport on an annual basis.

Applications are available at Keyportonline.com under the FORMS tab then Board of Health.

You must present a rabies certification that is valid through October of the issuing year.

The fees are as follows dogs \$8.20 for spayed or neutered and \$11.20 if they are not.

The Library is a part of the STELLA (Sharing & Technology Enhancing Local Library Access) Consortium which has reciprocal borrowing with over 40 libraries in the area. The Keyport Library offers books, audio books, DVDs, magazines, eBooks, eMagazines, electronic resources, museum passes, and a Library of Things (DVD players, fishing poles, telescope, etc.). There are monthly programs for adults, teens, tweens, and children. It is a fine-free Library.

Every summer the Library provides a Summer Reading Program that helps kids retain what they learned through the school year by reading. It is not reading instruction but rather incentivized reading to keep them practicing. Kids, teens, and adults can win prizes for reading and attend programs that both teach and entertain.
