

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND WAGES FOR DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT AND THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL 68-68A-68B, AFL-CIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Keyport, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective retroactively to January 1, 2021 the following minimum and maximum annual salary ranges are hereby established for the designated employee titles included in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Borough of Keyport and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 68-68A-68B, AFL-CIO:

SECTION 2. The salary ranges and maximum hourly wage rates established in this Ordinance shall continue in effect until subsequently amended.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any section or provision shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect, retroactive to January 1, 2021, after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
