**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL
OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT, IN THE
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW
JERSEY AMENDING BOROUGH CODE CHAPTER
7A (TRAFFIC SCHEDULES) SCHEDULE XIII
(LOADING ZONES)**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "**Borough**"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, desires to amend Chapter 7A (Traffic Schedules), Schedule XIII (Loading Zones) to add a loading zone located on the south side of West Front Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Keyport, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, Chapter 7A (Traffic Schedules), Schedule XIII (Loading Zones) to shall be amended as follows (additions are shown in ***bold italics with underlines***):

Section 1. Chapter 7A, Schedule XIII of the Borough Code is hereby amended as follows:

Schedule XIII. Loading Zones.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 7-7, the following described locations are hereby designated as loading zones:

Name of Street	Time	Sides	Location
Main Street		West	Beginning at a point 25 feet southerly of the intersection of the curbline of West Front Street and Main Street running thence 87 feet southerly
Union Street	Mon.-Fri.; 7:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.	South	School zone: Beginning at a point 239 feet west of the west curbline of Atlantic Street and extending to a point 150 feet westerly therefrom
West Front Street	Wednesday, 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.	North	Beginning at a point 185 feet westerly of the intersection of the curbline of Broad Street and West Front Street and extending to a point 50 feet westerly thereof
<i><u>West Front Street</u></i>		<i><u>South</u></i>	<i><u>Beginning at a point 550 feet west of the westerly curb line of Beers Street running to a point 600 feet west of the westerly curb line of Beers Street</u></i>

Section 2. The effective date for this Ordinance shall be May 20, 2025.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.
